Competition Entries Policy

Policy Rationale

This document outlines the policy by which BTYC Gymnastics Programs abide by to enter BTYC into competitions. BTYC Gymnastics Club enters athletes across all disciplines into an average of 20 competitions each year. The policy covers all Invitationals, Club Championships, State Championships and National Championships.

Policy Description and rationale

At the beginning of the year, BTYC Program Managers nominate which competitions will be entered into for the year, along with an estimate of the number of athletes expected to compete in each competition. Competitions are announced to families at this time with the exception of some programs which are announced later in the year.

Program Managers enter gymnasts into the chosen competitions four weeks prior to the competition date (with the exception of some competitions). Once entered parents are liable for the cost of the competition. If a child is required to withdraw due to injury, a medical certificate is required covering the date of the competition.

Any families who withdraw their child prior to the entries being submitted (approx. 1 month in advance of the competition) will be refunded or not charged their entry fee for that competition. However, any families who withdraw their child after entries have been submitted to event organisers, will not receive any refund, unless a medical certificate is provided covering the date of the competition.

Families who enter their child after entries are due, may be required to pay the entry fee amount plus any penalty fees imposed by the competition organisers.
